

Have it handy as you will need it to for the entry form.



If you get thirsty after flights, make sure to buy enough water before you board the airplane to India. It can take up to 1 hour from you arrive until you get a chance to buy water.



I highly recommend buying a SIM card at the airport. It will make communication home much cheaper and within India much easier. Outside the airport it is near impossible for foreigners to get SIM cards. (IDEA is the only provider with 3G, SIM plus one month 3G appprox. 1000 INR).



If you planned ahead you will find a taxi driver with a sign with your name on it. If not, you will wish you had done so;) (Approx. 1300 INR)



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
Once you get to immigration make sure you're standing in the line for foreigners, otherwise you might wait for nothing.



To buy the SIM card and pay the driver you will need some cash. Money exchange can be found inside the Airport. The ATM is just outside the doors.



The second easiest way to get to The Sand Castle is to take a prepaid taxi. The counter for this is inside the airport. (Approx. 1100 INR, plus tip)



There is also a bus service. If you're brave and on a low budget you can take it, but I don't recommend it for first timers or anyone else for that matter.

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
